Application Guidelines for [国家建設高水平大学公派研究生項目]

To individuals who wish to study abroad at Fujita Health University under the China State-Sponsored Postgraduate Study Abroad Program (**CSC – FHU Joint Scholarship Program**)

Fujita Health University invites students from China who wish to enroll for Doctoral degree program in October 2024 and April 2025 to apply under the China State-Sponsored Postgraduate Study Abroad Program ("国家建設高水平大学公派研究生項目"), according to the terms and conditions below.

The scholarship will be granted to up to 5 students who passed the selection by Fujita Health University.

1. Eligibility criteria

The applicant has been or will be granted a master's degree by the time they will be enrolling the Doctoral course at Fujita Health University.

2. How to apply

If you meet the eligibility criteria in point 1, please submit the following documents to your potential Professor/Supervisor.

Please note that all documents must be prepared in Japanese or English.

Application form

The form can be downloaded from the Fujita Health University's website.

• Letter of reference (using letterhead).

Referees should be a dean or academic advisor at the university to which the applicant belongs/belonged.

• Master's (or prospective) Degree Certificate from the last university the applicant attended.

If the certificate is written in a language other than Japanese or English, a Japanese or English translation must be attached.

- Academic Transcript from the university you are currently attending or graduated from. If the transcript is written in a language other than Japanese or English, a Japanese or English translation must be attached.
- Other documents required by the graduate school.

Application period:

First Round Application: November 1, 2023 – December 22, 2023 (Application has ended) Second Round Application: January 9, 2024 – January 26, 2024 (Application is open)

3. Enrollment Period

October 2024 or April 2025

4. Selection Method and Result Announcement

- Applicants will be selected based on a comprehensive documents screening process by Graduate School and Center for International Relations.
- Letter of Acceptance will be sent to the successful applicant through the Center for International Relations (late February 2024).

Successful applicants who receive a Letter of Acceptance issued by our university are not

required to submit Notification of Acceptance when applying to CSC.

5. Procedures After Receiving Letter of Acceptance

- Applicants who receive a letter of acceptance must submit their Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Program (CSC-FHU Joint Scholarship Program) application to the CSC. (Please confirm the schedule with the CSC.)
- Once complete, applicants should then inform their faculty advisor of the results of their screening by the CSC.
- Applicants must then take the entrance examination for the doctoral program of the graduate school at Fujita Health University to which they wish to enroll.
- Fujita Health University will inform the results of entrance examination to CSC.
- Applicants who passed the CSC screening must promptly submit a copy of the certificate of Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Program issued by CSC (in both English and Chinese) during enrollment procedures for their graduate school of choice.

6. Support details

[Provided by Fujita Health University]

Enrollment fee and tuition fee for Doctoral program will be exempted.

Only tuition fees for the standard course term of the Doctoral program are covered by the University.

[Provided by CSC]

CSC will provide each scholarship recipient with a living allowance, including medical insurance costs, and one round-trip economy class ticket between China and Japan, in accordance with Chinese government regulations. The duration of the living allowance to the recipients shall be based on the standard term of study from the time of the decision to receive the allowance, up to a maximum of 48 months (as of 2023, monthly allowance provided approx. JPY 170,000/month)

7. Please note.

- Submitted application documents cannot be returned under any circumstances.
- This tuition fee support system will be implemented on the premise that CSC will recruit individuals who wish to study for a Doctoral program at Fujita Health University
- Doctoral students who have passed the selection process for the Chinese Government

Graduate Student Overseas Study Program should comply with regulations outlined by Fujita Health University after enrolling the university.
