Board Representatives: Chief Coordinator and Deputy Coordinators are nominated by ISPRM President. Other Board Representatives are recommended by the Chief Coordinator and approved by the President's Cabinet (PC).

1. Chief Coordinator – 1 (position filled)
2. Deputy Coordinator - 2 (1 position vacant)
3. General Secretary – 1 (position filled)
4. Deputy Secretary – 2 (vacant)
5. Board Member - 3 (vacant)
6. Immediate past Chief Coordinator - 1 (not available)
7. PC liaison – 1 (ex-officio member to facilitate communication and decision-making)

Country Ambassadors & General Membership: There will be one official Country Ambassador per country and unlimited number of General Members. The recommendations are made by the Chief Coordinator or at least two Board members of the task force and approved by the President's Cabinet of ISPRM.

Eligibility:

- Any current PRM resident, fellows, early-career specialist (up to 5 years after becoming PRM specialist), or medical student.
- An active ISPRM Individual member in good standing is required.
